

## INTRODUCTION



The close proximity of the Township of Muskoka Lakes to the urban populations of Ontario and northern United States has contributed to its historic and contemporary role as an iconic cottaging, recreation and tourism destination. The Township's small communities, waterfront and rural areas provide an attractive lifestyle to its residents.

In the face of global change, the Township understands the need to take a leadership role in protecting the features that make our community unique so that future generations can also enjoy the Muskoka experience.

Consultation with a variety of community members revealed the following clear themes, which have been the basis for setting the strategic goals and initiatives for the Township:

- The Township of Muskoka Lakes is known for its natural beauty and must protect its environment from overdevelopment;
- There are opportunities to build a year-round economy that intertwines the natural beauty with the economy, through things like eco-tourism, research, and building a true knowledge economy;
- There is a need to address a significant and noticeable social and economic divide between the year-round and seasonal populations;
- There is a need for the Township to proactively advocate and secure broadband infrastructure to connect its residents and businesses.

The Strategic Plan contains a series of goals to protect that which is cherished, support business retention and expansion, as well as continuously improve the services and programs that meet the evolving needs and priorities of our community."



# Preserve and Protect the Natural and Cultural Environment

## To Preserve and Protect the Natural and Cultural Environment, the Township will:

- Continue to preserve and protect the natural features of the Muskoka watershed found within the Township, including water quality.
- Preserve, protect, and promote the heritage and cultural features that make Muskoka Lakes unique.
- Leverage local and regional relationships to strengthen our response to climate change, and ensure that Muskoka Lakes remains adaptable and resilient in its effects.
- Communicate, market, and promote the use and preservation of our natural environment, including creating dynamic downtowns that highlight the natural environment and highlighting access to the waterfront.
- Enhance the clarity of understanding and enforceability of septic management policies, practices, and infrastructure, and support these through greater education of, and communication, to users.







# Strengthen and Diversify Muskoka Lakes' Economy

To Strengthen and Diversify Muskoka Lakes' Economy, the Township will:

- Prioritize the implementation of the economic development strategy, including the housing, workforce, broadband, and transportation enablers of economic development.
- Set an economic development vision, and establish criteria to assess and prioritize desired types of economic growth for the Township, particularly light industrial, commercial, knowledgebased and year-round amenities and activities.
- Leverage existing Township infrastructure to foster accessible and affordable community hubs that support a thriving community, with a focus on year-round amenities, cultural attractions, and ancillary services that contribute positively to a high quality of life.



## Enhance and Sustain Public Services and Infrastructure



#### To Enhance and Sustain Public Services and Infrastructure, the Township will:

- Develop and implement an actionable recreation and trails master plan that improves community and visitor usage of the Township's infrastructure and natural features.
- Develop and implement a transportation master plan that identifies opportunities to maintain and enhance the Township's vital multi-modal transportation infrastructure.
- Maintain a focus on organizational excellence, accountability, and responsibility, strengthen staff engagement, and support staff with training necessary to effectively deliver services to residents.
- Assess the Township's current service delivery models and identify opportunities for modernization, digitization, and enhanced customer service engagement.




## Strengthen Key Relationships



### To Strengthen Key Relationships, the Township will:

- Conduct a thorough review of the Township's existing Municipal, Provincial, Federal and Indigenous government relationships that includes an assessment of influence (on the Township), financial impact (e.g. how designations affect funding opportunities), and opportunities for increased collaboration.
- Improve communications activities between the Township and other governments to facilitate better working relationships and information-sharing in support of legislated mandates and strategic priorities.
- Identify specific measures that, if achieved, will improve the Township's governance, fiscal, and programmatic relationship with the District.
