

## Quick Reference Guide - Election Sign By-Law 2018-039

### Election Signs Must:

- Not Be Installed on Private Property Prior to August 19th
- Not Be Installed on Road Allowances Prior to September 24, 2022
- Be Removed by October 27, 2022
- Not Be Installed Within 100m of a Voting Place
- Not Be Within 50m of Another Sign For the Same Candidate
- Not Be Placed on Public Property without Permission
- Not Be Placed on an Existing Sign
- Not Be Placed on any Natural Object (Tree, Rock, Etc.)
- Not Be Placed on a Centre Median
- Not Be Placed Within a Sight Triangle
- Never Hinder Pedestrian or Vehicular Traffic
- Not Bear a Township of Muskoka Lakes Logo

No person shall remove, relocate or deface any lawfully installed election sign.

By-Law 2018-039 provides regulation for all election signs. For further information or clarification, please read the by-law in its entirety. As we approach the municipal election, it is important for Candidates and Third Party Advertisers to stay apprised of this information and ensure compliance.
