

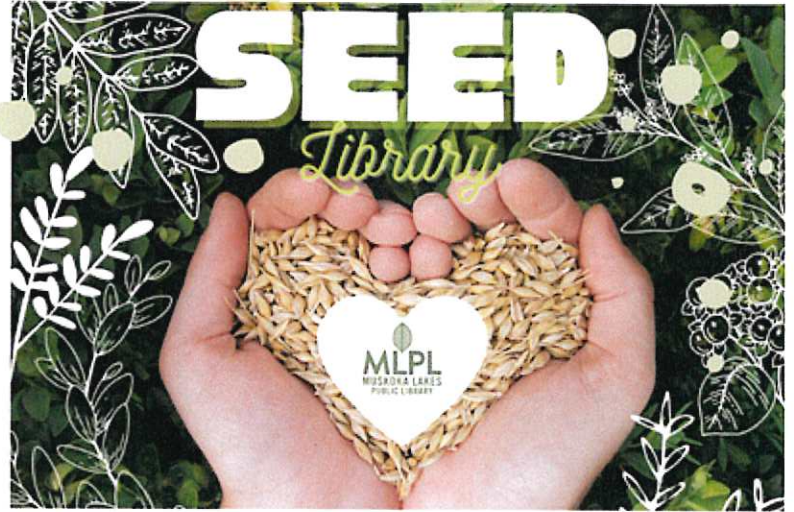
BORROW GROW SHARE
