"911" CIVIC SIGNING

INSTALLATION GUIDELINES

- The "911" number plate must be acquired from the Municipality and installed in a prominent location to be clearly visible from the principal access point to your residence (road or water). The "911" plate may be installed on your home, cottage or boathouse provided they can be easily seen from the road or water.
- Should your residence not be clearly visible from the road or water we recommend that they be installed on a post, approximately 4 to 6 feet above grade, at a location close to the road or water.

For installations near the road we recommend they be kept back at least 20 feet from the travelled road to minimize the snow cover from Municipal snow clearing equipment.

We also recommend that you contact the local utility (hydro, bell, cable) to ensure there are no buried cables in the location where the post is to be installed.

The Township has available, for a small fee, galvanized steel posts specifically designed for this installation.

 The signs <u>MUST NOT</u> be installed on trees, mail boxes, fence posts, hydro/bell poles, traffic sign posts or moveable objects.
